Application

All information must be accurate, legible and complete to give the best picture of your request. If requested information is not available, please explain why that information is not included or how it can be obtained.

Eligibility

Any Seventh-day Adventist ministry is eligible for funding from Northwest ASI as long as:

- Is a member in good standing in the Northwest Chapter of ASI.
- The organization is a qualified non-profit with an IRS 501(c)(3) determination or has a comparable status.
- Must have a representative attending and able to present at the April 11-12 Northwest ASI Spring Conference in Walla Walla, WA.

Amount of Funding

The ASI NW board is responsible for allocating offering funds, and typically two or three applicants are selected each year. Each of these applicants will receive a portion of the offering with the remaining portion going to support ASI NW projects and conference expenses. Approved funding amount may be different from the amount requested. Below are the funding allocations from the last two years:

2024 Funding – \$4,000 Creation Illustrated, \$4000 Young Disciple Ministries, \$4,000 ASI Northwest

2023 Funding - \$4,320 Mara Vision, \$4,320 Creation Illustrated, \$4,000 ASI Northwest

Application Deadline

All funding applications must be received by March 14, 2025. Don't hesitate to get in touch with NWASI to confirm your application has been received. Our email is info.asinw@gmail.com.

Funding Period

If approved, funding will begin in the year following the annual ASI Northwest Conference.

Funding Requirements Checklist

Completed Funding Application

Project Budget ☐

Include a detailed budget for the project. List all items necessary to accomplish project objectives. The budget should clearly and specifically identify sources of all anticipated contributions.

Board Minutes ☐

Submit a copy of your organization's board and/or executive committee minutes showing approval for this project.

Non-Profit Status ☐

For US-based applicants, submit a copy of the IRS letter indicating your organization's eligibility for non-profit status under the applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended. This should include the Federal Tax exemption certificate 501(c)(3). For non-US applicants please attach government-issued documents demonstrating non-profit status.

Accountability

If your project is approved, a report will be required to account for ASI funds received and the project's progress. Following completion of the project, a report must be provided detailing how the project advanced to completion and its impact on your community. If possible and applicable, a photograph should accompany the report.
